# सैनिकी शाळेने दिली जीवनाला दिशा

## गोस्पाक सलीम पटेल न्युनिअर सेफ्टी ऑफिसर, विलास जावडेकर डेव्हलपर्स



आपल्याकडील जान किंवा कौशल्य दसऱ्याला दिले तरच त्याचा उपयोग होतो. महिला, लहान मुले, तरुणी यांना सेल्फ डिफेन्सचे प्रशिक्षण देताना आपण काहीतरी चांगले काम करत आहोत याचे समाधान मला मिळते. हे क्षेत्र आव्हानात्मक असून येथे टिकून राहण्यासाठी सराव गरजेचा असतो. सध्या याच सराव आणि परीक्षा देण्यावर मी भर देतोय.

प्रत्येकाच्या आयुष्यात एखादा प्रसंग, एखादी व्यक्ती, एखादी संस्था प्रेरणा देणारी ठरते आणि यातूनच ध्येय गाठण्याच्या दिशेने प्रवास सुरू होतो. हे ध्येय अवघड आणि आव्हानात्मक असले तरीही काही लोक जिद्द बाळगून ते गाठतात. अशीच गोष्ट व्हीजेमध्ये ज्युनिअर सेफ्टी ऑफिसर म्हणून काम करणाऱ्या गौस्पाक सलीम पटेल याची. गौस्पाक सैनिकी शाळेत शिक्षणासाठी गेला आणि येथेच त्याला कराटे चॅम्पियन होण्याचे स्वप्न गवसले. सध्या तो नोकरी करण्याबरोबरच कराटे प्रशिक्षक म्हणूनदेखील काम करतोय. एका छोट्याशा गावातून आलेल्या या मुलाला या खेळाने आत्मविश्वास दिला आणि स्वप्न पाहण्याचं बळदेखील.

मुळचे कुपसुंगी (ता. मंगळवेढा, जि. सोलापूर) येथील गौस्पाकचे वडील पुण्यात नोकरी करायचे. नोकरीमुळे त्यांना मुलाच्या अभ्यासाकडे लक्ष देणे शक्य होत नव्हते. त्यामुळे त्यांनी गौस्पाकला गावी ठेवण्याचा निर्णय घेतला. होस्टेलला राहून शालेय शिक्षण घेत असलेला गौस्पाक सामान्य जीवन जगत होता. तोपर्यंत शाळा, होस्टेल आणि दैनंदिन जीवन या गोष्टी सोडून बाहेरच्या जगाशी त्याचा संबंध नव्हता. मात्र आठव्या इयत्तेत गेल्यावर त्याने सांगलीतील संस्कार-आविष्कार गुरुकुल या सैनिकी शिक्षण देणाऱ्या शाळेत प्रवेश घेतला आणि येथेच त्याच्या जीवनाला दिशा मिळाली. शिक्षणाचा भाग म्हणून सैनिकी शाळेत वेगवेगळ्या उपक्रमांचे आयोजन केले जायचे. एक दिवस शाळेत ब्रुस ली या मार्शल आर्टिस्टचा सिनेमा दाखवण्यात आला. या चित्रपटातील कराटेचे प्रकार बघून गौस्पाकच्या मनात कुतुहल निर्माण झाले आणि तेव्हापासून त्याला कराटे शिकण्याचा ध्यास जडला.

लहानपणापासून गावाकडील वातावरणात वाढल्याने गौस्पाकला नवीन गोष्टी जुळवून घेण्यात, आत्मविश्वासाने

चारचौघात वावरण्यात अडचणी आल्या. मात्र, त्याने आपल्या खेळातून त्यावर मात केली. सैनिकी शाळेत विविध खेळांचे प्रशिक्षण विद्यार्थ्यांना दिले जायचे. गौस्पाकने ठरविल्याप्रमाणे कराटेची निवड केली आणि त्याचे प्रशिक्षण सुरू झाले. सैनिकी शाळेत असल्याने शिस्तीचे वातावरण होतेच. पहाटेपासून सुरु झालेला दिनक्रम संध्याकाळी संपायचा. यामध्ये पहाटे परेड. व्यायाम यांचा सराव झाला की ९ ते २ शाळा आणि त्यानंतर कराटेचे प्रशिक्षण असा गौस्पाकचा दिवस जायचा. रिटायर आर्मी अधिकाऱ्यांच्या मार्गदर्शनाखाली हा सराव रोज होत असे. सलग तीन वर्षे कराटेचे विविध प्रकार येथे गौस्पाकला शिकायला मिळाले. या तीन वर्षात आत्मविश्वास वाढला आणि आपण जीवनात काहीतरी वेगळे काम करू शकू यासाठी बळ मिळाले.

दहावीनंतर पुढील शिक्षण घेण्यासाठी गौस्पाक पुण्यात दाखल झाला. तळेगाव येथील संत तुकाराम पॉलिटेक्निक कॉलेजमध्ये त्याने मेकॅनिकल इंजिनीअरिंगला प्रवेश घेतला आणि याचबरोबर संरक्षण दलात काम करण्याची इच्छा असल्याने त्यासाठी असलेल्या परीक्षादेखील देण्यास सुरुवात केली. परंत्, दुर्देवाने त्यात अपयश आले. यातून खचून न जाता त्याने कराटेच्या माध्यमातून करिअरची वेगळी वाट निवडण्याचा निर्धार केला आणि पुण्यातील ओशू इंटरनॅशनल मार्शल आर्ट्समध्ये पुढील प्रशिक्षणासाठी प्रवेश घेतला. येथे कराटेचे वेगवेगळे टप्पे, परीक्षा, प्रकार यांमध्ये तो पारंगत होत गेला. फक्त कराटेचे शिक्षण घेऊन स्पर्धांमध्ये सहभागी होण्यावर गौस्पाक

थांबला नाही. आपण जे शिक्षण आणि प्रशिक्षण घेतले आहे त्याचा इतरांनाही फायदा व्हावा, आपल्याकडे असलेले ज्ञान इतरांपर्यंतही पोहोचावे यासाठी त्याने प्रयत्न सुरू केले. महिला आणि लहान मुलांना सेल्फ डिफेन्ससोबतच कराटेचे धडे देण्यासाठी क्लासेस सुरू करण्याचा निर्णय घेतला आणि याची मुहूर्तमेढ आकुर्डी येथून रोवली गेली. येथील एका सोसायटीमधील मुलांना त्याने कराटेचे धडे द्यायला सुरुवात केली. त्यावेळी त्याच्याकडे ४५ विद्यार्थी कराटेचे प्रशिक्षण घेण्यासाठी यायचे. हळूहळू हे काम वाढले आणि पुण्यात विविध ठिकाणी कराटे प्रशिक्षण देणे सुरू झाले.

आजच्या घडीला तो कराटेच्या विविध प्रकारांमध्ये पारंगत आहे. तसेच त्याला दांडपट्टा, लाठीकाठी यांसारखे प्रकारदेखील त्याला खेळता येतात. इतरांना प्रशिक्षण देण्याबरोबरच तो स्वतःदेखील कराटेच्या पुढील परीक्षा आणि प्रकारांसाठी प्रशिक्षण घेतो आहे. तसेच विविध खासगी कार्यालये, शाळा कॉलेज येथील महिला, विद्यार्थिनी यांना सेल्फ डिफेन्सचे घडेदेखील तो देतो. पिंपरी-चिंचवड महानगरपालिकेच्या सौदामिनी या उपक्रमाअंतर्गत पुण्यातील शाळांमध्ये विद्यार्थ्यांना मोफत सेल्फ डिफेन्सचे प्रशिक्षण देतो. आजपर्यंत शेकडो विद्यार्थांना त्याने हे प्रशिक्षण दिले

अवध्या २२ वर्षांचा हा तरुण नोकरी करून स्वतःची आवड जपण्याचा प्रयत्न करतो आहे. देशभरात झालेल्या विविध स्पर्धांमध्ये त्याने सहभाग नोंदवला आहे. तसेच महिला आणि तरुणींना सेल्फ डिफेन्सचे मोफत प्रशिक्षण देण्यासाठी तो प्रयत्नशील असतो. साधारण २०१८ मध्ये त्याने कराटे प्रशिक्षण देण्यास सुरुवात केली. वर्ष-दोन वर्षात त्याच्याकडे लहान मुलांपासून ते वयस्कर मंडळींपर्यंत अशा सगळ्यांनीच प्रशिक्षण घेतले. तसेच पोलिसांनादेखील त्याने मार्शल आर्टचे प्रशिक्षण दिले आहे. गौस्पाक देत असल्याने प्रशिक्षणामध्ये केवळ सेल्फ डिफेन्सच नाही तर थरारक खेळांचेही प्रशिक्षण तो देतो. आपल्या विद्यार्थ्यांना सोप्यापासून अवघडाकडे नेत त्यांना कणखर बनविण्याचा प्रयत्न करतो. लहान मुलांना पोटावरून चालायला लावणे, हाताने वीट तोडणे, पोटावरून गाडी नेणे या सर्व थरारक गोष्टींचा अनभव त्याने घेतला आहे. आपल्या विद्यार्थ्यांनीही या

क्षेत्रातील आव्हाने स्वीकारून कणखर व्हावे यासाठी तो प्रयत्नशील असतो.

दोन वर्षांपूर्वी संपूर्ण जग थांबविणाऱ्या कोविड महामारीच्या काळात कराटे क्लासेसदेखील थांबले. संपूर्ण जगच थांबल्याने प्रत्येकाला घरात बसण्यावाचून पर्याय उरला नाही आणि गौस्पाकलादेखील या गोष्टीचा सामना करावा लागला. कराटे प्रशिक्षण बंद झाल्याने तो घरीच असायचा. त्यावेळी वडील सलीम पटेल यांनी त्याला नोकरी करण्याचा सल्ला दिला आणि गौस्पाकने बांधकाम क्षेत्रात पाऊल टाकले. वडील पूर्वीपासूनच या क्षेत्रात असल्याने त्यांच्या मार्गदर्शनाने तो व्हीजेमध्ये इलेक्ट्रिक विभागात रूज् झाला. एका बांधकाम प्रकल्पांच्या साइट्सवर काम करताना त्याची भेट सेफ्टी ऑफिसरशी झाली. त्यांना सेफ्टी क्षेत्रातील करिअरची माहिती दिली. तसेच त्यासंदर्भात असलेल्या कोर्सची माहिती दिली. गौस्पाकने वेळ न दवडता सेफ्टी टेनिंगचा ऑनलाइन कोर्स पूर्ण केला. त्यानंतर अडव्हान्स डिप्लोमा इन इंडस्ट्रिअल सेफ्टीचे शिक्षण घेऊन ज्युनिअर सेफ्टी ऑफिसर म्हणून पुढे कार्यरत झाला. सध्या तो याच क्षेत्रातील पुढील शिक्षण घेतो आहे. व्हीजेमध्ये काम सुरु करून त्याला आता एक वर्ष पूर्ण झाले आहे. उदरनिर्वाहासाठी करिअरचा ट्रॅंक त्याने बदलला असला तरीही आपले ध्येय त्याने सोडलेले नाही. आजही तो दिवसभर काम करून विद्यार्थ्यांना कराटेचे प्रशिक्षण द्यायला जातो. सध्या त्याच्याकडे २५ विद्यार्थी कराटेचे प्रशिक्षण घेताय तर तो स्वतः कराटेचे पुढील प्रशिक्षण घेतो आहे. यावरून त्याची कराटेविषयी असलेली जिह अधोरेखित होतेय.

Coming from a small village, the sport gave him confidence and strength to dream. His father, originally from Kupsungi (Tal. Mangalvedha, Dist. Solapur) used to work in Pune. As the job did not allow him to focus on his child's studies, he decided to keep Gouspak in the village. Gouspak lived in a hostel and went to school there and had no connection with the outside world. However, after passing eighth standard, he entered the Sanskar-Avishkar Gurukul, a military school in Sangli, where he found a direction in his life. As part of the education, various activities were organized in

the military school. One day at school, a movie of Bruce Lee, a martial artist was shown. The movie aroused Gouspak's curiosity and since then he started practising karate.

Growing up in a village, Gouspak had difficulty adapting to new things due to lack of confidence. However, he gained confidence through karate. Though students were trained in various sports in the military school, Gouspak chose karate as planned and began his training. Being in a military school, there was an atmosphere of discipline and the routine started in the morning and ended in the evening. During morning parade,

exercise session was from 9 to 2, which was conducted daily under the guidance of retired Army officers. For three years in a row, Gouspak got to learn different types of karate styles. These three years gave him confidence and strength to do something different in life.

Gouspak arrived in Pune for further studies after 10th standard. He enrolled in Sant Tukaram Polytechnic College, Talegaon in Mechanical Engineering and also started preparing for the examinations as he wanted to work for the self-Defense Forces. But, unfortunately, he failed. Undeterred, he decided to pursue a career in karate and entered the Osho International Martial Arts in Pune for further training. Here he became proficient in different stages and types of karate. Gouspak apart from participating in competitions began to impart knowledge and training he had received to others. He decided to start karate classes for women and children in Akurdi. Initially, he started with only 45 students and gradually his work increased and he started his classes at various places in Pune. teaching hundreds of students.

22-year-old Gouspak has participated in various competitions across the country since 2018 and he specializes in various forms of karate. He has also given martial arts training to the police. He also gives self-defence lessons to women and students in various private offices, schools and colleges.

He also participates actively in other sports and trains students mentally

as well. He has imparted several training methods to children like making them walk on their stomach, breaking bricks with their hands or driving cars on boards on their stomach. He strives to make his students resilient by accepting the challenges in this field.

However, Gouspak's karate classes came to a halt during the COVID pandemic and he had no choice but to stay at home. At that time, his father Salim Patel advised him to get a job and Gouspak stepped into the field of construction and under his guidance joined the electrical department at VJ. While working on a construction project site, he met a safety officer who briefed him on building a career in the field of Safety. Gouspak completed an online course in safety training and after completing his Advanced Diploma in Industrial Safety, started working as a Junior Safety Officer. He is currently pursuing further studies in this field. It's been a year since he started working at VJ. Although he changed his career path for a living, he did not give up. Even today, he works all day to teach karate to the students. At present, he has 25 students who take karate training under him.

Expressing his experience in karate training, Gouspak says, "It is useful to pass on one's knowledge or skills to others. I am satisfied that I am doing something good while training women, children and youth in self defence. This field is challenging and requires practice to survive. At the moment, I am focusing on practice and giving exams in karate."

Mr. Aditya Javdekar and interacted with him. They got the answers to all their questions from our team members and also got to see the progress of their units.



## MULA-MUTHA RIVER REJUVENATION PROGRAMME

RIVERS ARE CALLED JEEVANDAAYINI (LIFE GIVER). ALL MAJOR CIVILIZATIONS IN HUMAN HISTORY HAVE DEVELOPED BESIDES RIVER. BUT TODAY, IN THIS ERA OF URBANIZATION, RIVERS HAVE LOST THEIR OWN EXISTENCE. THE MOST FAMILIAR EXAMPLE FOR US, PUNEKARS, IS OF MULA-MUTHA RIVER.

#### CURRENT SITUATION



#### PROPOSED PLAN



River Mula and Mutha are very important rivers passing through centre of Pune city bifurcating the PMC and PCMC areas. The twin cities are experiencing heavy urbanization from past few decades which has created pressure on these rivers.

The rivers have become largely inaccessible from the city and are no longer seen as assets to the city. The city has turned its back to these rivers. In order to cope with these current issues and create

meaningful public realm along the rivers, Pune Municipal Corporation has instigated a comprehensive project - Mula, Mutha and Mula-Mutha Riverfront Development Project in entire Pune Municipal corporation area.

There are three rivers passing through Pune Municipal Corporation area namely Mula, Mutha and Mula-Mutha, with an approximate total length of 44kms and widths varying from 80mts to 250mts. Out of this, 22.2km is Mula River, 10.4km is

Mutha River and 11.8km is Mula Mutha River.

Both Mula and Mutha Rivers are dammed in their upstream. Mutha River has three dams- Khadakwasla, Warasgaon and Temghar while Mula River has Mulshi Dam that controls the release of water in the rivers. The rainfall only in the catchment area below the dams finds its way into the rivers.

Pune's Rivers have been degraded over time. This is due to a number of



factors like urbanization along river, construction of dams, release of untreated sewage into the river, lack of access, poor connectivity across the banks etc.

Pune Municipal Corporation had announced a programme to revive these rivers back in 2016. And after a long wait of 6 years it is now being turned into reality.

The Rs 4,727-crore project is being implemented to clean the river and make it pollution-free, reducing the risk of flooding, making the entire riverbank accessible to the public, retaining water, improving the city's connectivity to the riverfront and integrating existing heritage structures, recreational, religious and socio-cultural activities.

The civic body has decided to set up nine new sewage treatment plants (STP) under the National River Cleanliness and Development (NRCD) scheme and two under riverfront development in addition to the existing 11 sewage treatment plants to ensure no untreated sewage is released in the river.

It has decided to ensure 79 per cent of green embankments to reduce the risk of flooding with 33.9-km of rural riparian, 38.8-km of urban riparian and 19.8-km with engineered sections. The entire project has been divided into 11 phases and and the work in the first four phases will be carried out under PPP (Public Private Partnership) model.

The first phase of the project, for which tender have been called, would include beautification of the riverbank from Bundgarden to Sangam Ghat, laying of cycle tracks along the riverside, developing greenery along the cycle track to maintain temperature. A boating activity has also been proposed in this phase.

The project proposes to build different embankments to avoid

flooding in the low lying areas. Another objective of the project is to stop the sewage from getting into the river directly. The proposed plan of open spaces, gardens and public promenades would preserve the natural environment along the riverside and would also make this area more accessible to people.



he heat of summer is finally here! With temperatures set to soar it's time to get your houseplants ready to handle the heat and switch into summer plant care mode.

Though some sun-loving plants like succulents and cacti are well adapted to high temperatures, plants that are kept indoors are not acclimated to the extremes of a summer heat wave. Leafy tropical are particularly susceptible to damage from heat, and if too severely damaged, might not recover.

Not to worry! There's plenty you can do in advance of and during the heat wave to make sure your indoor plants survive the heat. Here are some of the most important summer plant care tips

to get you started.

#### 1. Promote high humidity

Plants that like high humidity (many epiphytes and tropicals such as fittonia, calathea and most ferns) should be frequently misted through periods of heat. You can also fill a shallow dish with pebbles, fill with water, and set your pot on top to create a little humid microclimate for your plant that will provide humidity and help your plants survive summer.

#### 2. Water well, and water deeply

Proper watering is key to indoor plant care. Though over-watering is the most efficient way to kill your houseplant, heat and sun cause water to evaporate from soil at much faster rates. In preparation for a heat wave, be sure to give your plants a deep watering –

if you water too quickly or not enough, often just the top of the soil gets wet and the rest escapes down the sides of your pot and out the bottom. Make sure the water is actually absorbed by watering slowly, and allowing the plant to soak up excess water in a bowl for 10-20 after watering.

While you're in summer plant care mode, check your plants soil moisture level more frequently than normal, either by using a moisture meter, or with the trusty "finger test" – water when soil feels dry at 1-2 down for most tropical plants. Another key indicator of fast-drying, compacted soil is when the soil pulls away from the sides of the pot. If there's a gap between the soil and the side of the pot, it's time to rehydrate!

## 3. Shade sensitive plants from too much sun

Plants get sunburn, too. Plants that live in south and west-facing windows will get an especially bright dose of vitamin D during this weekend's heat wave. But since you can't put sunscreen on their leaves, it's best to move them a bit further into your house to spare them from this direct hit of the sun.

#### 4. Keep it cool

If you've ever felt faint in the heat, imagine what your plants must feel like! Do your best to keep your plants out of the hottest spots in your home while in summer plant care mode. This might mean moving them away from windows or even into other rooms during hot times.

Also, it may seem counterintuitive, but the best way to keep your house cool in the heat (assuming you don't have A/C) is actually to close your windows during the day when the heat is on, and open them back up at night when it cools down. If you can manage to get the house just a few degrees cooler, you'll feel a lot better, and so will your plants!

## 5. Don't fertilize during a heat wave

Though fertilizer is your friend, especially during summer, a stressed plant should never be fertilized until it recovers. When your plant is in summer survival mode, it's not looking for extra nutrients and isn't prepared to make use of them. Introducing these into the soil will risk further stressing your plant. Wait until it cools down a bit for your next



feeding!

### 6. Don't re-pot during a heat wave

Likewise, you shouldn't choose a 100+ degree day as the perfect moment to re-pot that root-bound ficus (or any other plant for that matter). Why? Leaves always get damaged during re-potting (and in fact, proper re-potting often involves trimming away a lot of the root mass). Re-potting will cause your plant to get a bit stressed (even though it's important plant maintenance in the long run) and this added stress could cause it to fail during the heat.

#### 7. Wait to prune

Why wait to prune off damaged leaves and stems until after the heat wave passes? You guessed it: stress. While a little pruning here and there often helps your plant spur new growth, immediately assuming that a leaf that's wilted or discoloured is a goner is not the best choice during a heat wave. When conditions get back to normal, the leaf might rebound. Plus, it might still be supporting

the overall health of the plant. And, of course, pruning does cause a bit of stress to your plant. It's best to wait until temperatures get a bit back in the normal range before snipping off leaves and stems that didn't make it.

#### 8. Learn to recognize stress

Last but certainly not least, being ready to catch problems early is key to stopping them before they take hold and ravage your indoor plants. Common signs of stress to keep in mind for summer plant care usually have to do with too much heat and too little water.

- Tropical plants, especially those with tender leaves, usually wilt with exposure to too much heat.
- Foliage that was once bright green may look pale when stressed.
- Sunburn manifests in a variety of ways, but often looks like a rough brown or yellow patch on leaves/ stems.
- Flowers (and leaves) often drop off or yellow when a plant is stressed

Initially I was a bit nervous, but as the work progressed, I gained confidence. And I am happy that I could deliver the stylish yet comfy attire as expected by VJ. It was a wonderful journey. VJ was always supportive. I enjoyed working with VJ as they gave me a free hand to work on different ideas.
