

ave you ever thought about where you would go when you want some peace or to soul search?

some of us would opt to stay at home, few would love to hike up the mountains, some would just go for a drive, and listen to music and some like me would hope to find this in a TEMPLE, where I believe God exists with whom I would find my peace!

The necessity of concentration on an embodied form of God was the main reason for TEMPLES to come into existence. However, the concentration of mind is necessary for establishing union with God. Recently I had the privilege of being part of the 'Dakshin Mukhi Maruti Mandir' (the south-facing Maruti idol) sthapana or cementing of the idol at our ongoing site VJ INDILIFE in Pashan. to us by many other names like Hanuman, Bajrang Bali, Mahabali and so on. Maruti is the Sanskrit name referring to Hanuman, son of the Hindu wind god, Pawan Dev.

The construction of the Mandir was already done at the site and the date fixed for the sthapana was the Ilth of December, a Saturday, in consultation with our Guruji. As we all gathered together for the puja, the positive vibrations of the mandir began to flow amongst us.

Soon our very own Javdekar family began with all the rituals; each ritual had its importance and kept us fascinated all through the process. One of the processes included performing an Abhishek (the process of giving a bath to the idol before the sthapana) of

the Maruti idol with coconut water. Seeing this made me curious to know why this was done and after digging out some information, this is what I gathered. Maruti is the son of the Lord of Vayu (wind) which makes him a very powerful God, so it's been a tradition to break coconuts in the temples every time you worship him. This also indicated that the sound of coconut breaking would drive away all the evil energies of the surroundings and bring in goodness among us!

In our Indian families we have been following such rituals and traditions from generations together, and so has Mrs. Kalpana Javdekar. She has beautifully entrenched such traditions amongst her family and us-Vliets, the extended family! I couldn't help but notice how much joy my heart was

filled with, the peace of mind which I achieved and the positivity this event brought to the place, to all VJites and within me.

ealth and Hygiene is of prime importance for everyone.

And it becomes a concern for those who do not have easy access to the resources. Labourers who usually stay at the temporary camps erected at the construction site not always get everything that a permanent resident easily claims.

John Marian, General Manager, Admin-Construction sites and Suresh Mahale, Manager-Safety arranged Health Awareness camp for labourers at YashOne Wakad Central and YashOne Infinitee sites in association with PCMC Health Department on December 22, 2021 and December 26, 2021 respectively. In the current pandemic situation, the focus of the lecture was obviously on COVID-19. The safety measures and precautions one has to take even after the vaccination has been done were explained to them.

Keeping in mind some addiction labourers usually have like chewing tobacco or smoking Bidis, the side effects or complications such habits can give rise to were told to them. They also received insight into how they can keep their camps clean by adopting some hygienic practices. Another topic covered in the lecture was HIV. A basic like what is HIV, how it is transmitted, how to prevent it were thrown light upon in this session.











PLANTS FOR HOME

GUIANA CHESTNUT PACHIRA

he Money Tree is a popular houseplant because of its resilience, ease of growth, and fun braided trunk. The decorative trunk crowned by foliage that grows almost horizontally makes Pachira an indoor tree with a joyous personality.

Pachira Aquatica is a commonly found houseplant called a money tree. The plant is also known as Malabar chestnut or Saba nut. Money tree plants often have their slender trunks braided together and are a low maintenance option for artificially lit areas. Money tree plant care is easy and based upon just a few specific conditions. Let's learn more about how to care for money tree houseplants.

Money tree plants are native from Mexico to northern South America. The trees can get up to 60 feet (18 m.) in their native habitats but are more commonly small, potted ornamental specimens. The plant has slim green stems topped with palmate leaves. In their native region, money tree plants produce fruits that are oval green pods divided into five chambers inside. The seeds within the fruit swell until the pod bursts. Roasted nuts taste a bit like chestnuts and can be ground into flour.

According to Chinese feng shui tradition, the leaves, with a bit of imagination look like green hands that capture happiness and good fortune, and the twisted stems store the treasure. In Asia, the plant is also called the money tree. There, it is a traditional housewarming gift that brings good fortune and happiness to the home. In China the number five represents the five elements, and that too makes the five-fingered leaves of the Pachira very popular.

The Pachira money tree is a perfect addition to the interior landscape and lends a tropical feel. If you want to have some fun, try starting your own Pachira money tree from seed or from cuttings.

These plants do best when they are in full sun to partial shade. The best temperatures are 60 to 65 F. (16-18 C.). Plant the tree in peat moss with some gritty sand.

BOCW provides a kit comprising a Helmet, safety jacket, safety shoes, harness, Essentials kit,
