MR. SURENDRA PATHARE, AN ENGINEER BY EDUCATION BUT A PHILANTHROPIST BY INTEREST, IS ENGAGED IN MANY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES THROUGH HIS NGO.

HERE WE PRESENT HIM IN AN EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW WITH OUR CEO, MR. ADITYA JAVDEKAR.

I has become a brand with trust because of the quality of construction it provides, the way VJ designs the entire project keeping in mind different needs of the people. But we believe, a developer's responsibility doesn't end there. Especially, when a project is launched in a developing area, the livability of the area, which comes through the basic infrastructure

available in that area, also matters a lot to make the life easy for the residents.

With this thought in mind, we launched this idea of VJ Parivartan, where we collaborate with the people like corporators, Politicians, Social Workers with high influence, who are and can be instrumental in the basic infrastructure development of the area. We call them

'growth agents'. We talk to them to understand how that area is shaping up, what their vision is and how it can benefit our customers in future.

The second interview in this series was done with Mr. Surendra Pathare at our Yashwin Orizzonte site where he revealed his plans for the development of Kharadi and surrounding areas.

# Pathare

Question: How have you seen Kharadi transforming in last decade?

Answer: In 2009-10, Kharadi was considered as an outskirt of Pune and people were unwilling to shift to Kharadi. But today it has become "BKC" of Pune. The infrastructure provided in Kharadi is better than rest of Pune. Many 5star hotels, CBSE, ICSE, IB schools as well as many mall or entertainment centers are coming up in and around Kharadi. The area also has easy connectivity to the airport. So today everybody wants to be kharadi. This is the major change I have observed in past

Question: As people are migrating to Kharadi what infrastructure projects are planned by Government or corporation to handle the pressure of this population? Answer: Good transportation facilities are important for the development of an area. Kharadi has a good network of wider roads where the width of the road is minimum 18 meters. Early in this decade, the biggest challenge faced by Kharadi was "Ample water supply". This area has very low levels of groundwater and was solely dependent on water supply schemes run by local bodies. To overcome this problem, the idea of a dedicated water project for eastern part of Pune was put forth in 2009. The work of the project "BHAMAASKHED" Dam was commenced in 2013. This project has helped resolve the water supply issue

to greater extent in eastern part of Pune. Today, areas like Upper Kharadi, Wagholi, Kesnand which may soon fall under PMC area are being provided the water through Bhama-Askhed Dam, reducing their dependency on the local water supply. So now Kharadi has ample water supply.

Question: Having an engineer as a public representative is a huge rarity. You are an engineer. What do you think should be done so that services will come first in an area and residents will follow afterwards?

Answer: Developers should work hand-in-hand with politicians and bureaucrats to make it happen.
Developers, as a moral responsibility, should also look beyond the boundaries of the projects to make these services

like roads, water etc. available and make their life easier after possession.

Question: Kharadi is known as fairly

safe suburb. But safety decreases with increasing population. What measures are being taken to ensure safety of all?

Answer: The population of Kharadi has increased ten folds in the past decade. Many IT companies are coming to Kharadi which work round the clock. Our senior politicians have already given the proposal for a separate police station for Kharadi. It will make use of new technologies. We are trying to bring every nook and corner of Kharadi under CCTV surveillance. We want to reduce dependency on manpower and shift to technically and technologically

advanced systems.

#### VJCONNECT

Question: In long term vision, is Kharadi missing something like a major urban development project or a tourism project to make it more habitable place for people?

**Answer:** Approaching Kharadi from other parts of the Pune or vice versa is difficult due to traffic jams on many roads though Kharadi itself has wider roads internally. This issue will be in focus in our plan. Today, Kharadi is all about Concrete structures and glass façade. We wish to make it "Green Kharadi" in coming years. Kharadi doesn't have a cultural center or auditorium where people can get together and feel like a part of bigger family. We will try to build at least one such center so that people don't have to go outside Kharadi. We also want to have at least two big gardens in Kharadi for senior citizens and children.

Question: So is there any provision made for these things in the proposed Development Plan for Kharadi?

**Answer:** Yes. Land reservations are there e.g. for auditorium. The land acquisition process is going on.

Kharadi already has biggest indoor sports facility after Balewadi. This 37000 sq.ft. Stadium is equipped with all facilities along with audience gallery where the play area is of 15000 sq.ft. We want to develop Zensar ground along the line of Nehru Stadium.

The problem of traffic jams can be resolved if you make services available to people within walking distance. If good schools, entertainment centers, sports facilities are available here in Kharadi itself then people don't have to go out of Kharadi unless for travelling to other cities.

Question: We just discussed about water problem. Kharadi has huge natural water body passing through it. Globally riverfront falls under premium location. But here we can't even walk on the river bank. Any developmental plans are on your mind for the same?

Answer: True. In last 15 yrs. these Mula and Mutha rivers which were once identity of Pune have shrunk considerably.

Many times we heard the discussions of cleaning them but nothing really happened. We have been in discussion with some bureaucrats in infrastructure development for past one and a half year about reviving these rivers. Eight months ago PMC has put forth a proposal to turn dead rivers into live rivers.

If I get an opportunity, it will be my priority to clean them and develop them like Sabarmati in Gujrat. It will make good impact on environment. The riverbanks will serve as tourism spot in the evening and sports facility in the morning.

Question: It's been heard that PMC has prepared DPR for river and riverfront development based on a similar case post world war II in its sister city Bremen in Germany where a dead river was turned into live river.

**Answer:** Yes. And the first phase of this project will serve the patch between Yerwada and Kharadi. This will be carried out in collaboration with some private developers.

These riverfronts can become point of global attraction and ground for live-in music concerts.

Question: Kharadi continues to be global hotspot in terms of offices. We see many commercial developments in the area.

What are these developments? What's the future of Kharadi?

Answer: Many big IT projects are coming up in Kharadi. They together will provide approx. 2.5-3 Cr. Sq.Ft. of commercial space that will cater to around 2.5 lakh employees. Behind every Sq. Ft. of office space 10 Sq. Ft. of residential space is developed. So the proportionate amount of residential spaces will be developed in Kharadi and surrounding area in next five years.

With the development of residential areas come other developments like eateries, entertainment hubs, malls, schools etc.
Today Kharadi has two IB schools and two more are proposed. Such developments will continue to happen.

Question: Given all these developments associated with commercial developments, my fundamentals of real estate say that the prices of residential spaces will continue to rise. What do you think?

Answer: The prices are dependent on Demand-supply cycle. The prices will definitely rise as the residential projects in comparison with commercial projects are not sufficient. Two years down the line there won't be enough residential spaces to cater to the demands then.

So those who have bought apartments in ongoing projects will see very good appreciation for their properties in coming couple of years.





आज असाच मी माझा एक अनुभव तुमच्यासोबत शेअर करणार आहे.

सागर म्हामुणकर साहेबांसोबत मला सर्वेश सरांच्या कामानिमित्त मंत्रालयात जायचे होते. दिवसभराचे काम आटोपून मी आणि सागर साहेब संध्याकाळी ७-८ चा दरम्यान पुण्याहून मुंबईच्या दिशेने निघालो, जाताना काहीतरी बाहेर च खाऊ म्हणून घरातून न जेवताच निघालो.

10 च्या दरम्यान आम्ही लोणावळ्याला जेवायला थांबलो. जेवण होईपर्यंत ११ वाजून गेले. मग आम्ही पुढच्या प्रवासाला निघालो. सर्व सुरळीत चालू होते. मी आणि सागर साहेब गप्पा मारत-मारत प्रवास करत होतो. रात्रीचे १.१५ वाजले होते. आम्ही बऱ्यापैकी प्रवास पूर्ण केला होता. रात्री च्या प्रवासात गाडया १००-१२० च्या वेगाने आमच्या बाजूने जात होत्या. आम्ही मात्र ७०-८० च्या वेगाने च पुढे सरकत होतो.

Today I will be sharing an incident that took place on one of my trips.

Sagar Mhamunkar Sir and I were on our way to the Mantralay in Mumbai regarding Sarvesh sir's work (or on behalf of Sarvesh Sir). Around 7:00 pm we left from Pune in 'Verito' towards Mumbai, we planned to have dinner on the way so we had not eaten anything at home.

Around 10 o'clock, we stopped near lonavala, had dinner and by the time we were done it was past 11, so we continued our journey. Everything was going smooth, we were busy talking so we did not realise the time. and around 1:15 we were about to end our journey as we were nearing Mumbai. It was really late at night so all the vehicles around us were moving at the speed of 100-120km/h, while we were at 70-80km/ h. Suddenly I heard a weird creaking sound, and my heart skipped a beat! After a while the car started moving weirdly and we realised that the tire had burst. Somehow, we managed to get the car to the side of the road and stop.

We both stepped out of the car and saw that the tire had burst completely, we were shocked but by god's grace we were both alright. But what next?.

As it was an expressway and really late at night, no vehicles stopped and were all speeding past us. After a lot of trying and waiting, luckily a police car passed by and stopped for us. The police gave me a lift till the garage and carried on with

their work, there were 2 to 3 tire shops around that garage, but it was really late so everybody was fast asleep and no one came for help.

I grabbed a rod which I saw near the shop and started walking back towards the car, Sagar sir was waiting in the car taking care of both the car and himself while I was gone.

anuary is about to get over but we are experiencing strong wave of cold all over Maharashtra. Many people around are suffering from cough and cold due to this sudden change in the weather. While we were thinking of putting away Razais and sweaters, we have again buried ourselves deep into the layers of warm clothes and we are trying to find some good food options to keep us warm.

Our traditional cuisines have been designed carefully to cater to the needs of the body in different seasons. In winters, we feel hungrier. Do you know why it is so? It is because the drop in our body temperatures which further stimulates appetite. Indian Winter Foods like Bajra, Til (Sesame seeds), Jaggery etc. generate heat in the body and keep us warm. Therefore we have the tradition of preparing Bajra Bhakri, TilGul poli on the occasion of Makar Sankranti. Let's have a look at such winter friendly dishes.



Bajra Khichdi: An alternative to regular moong dal khichadi. This can be enriched with vegetables like carrots, green peas etc. which are available in plenty during this season.



Bajra Roti and Baingan Bharta: It's the best combination for dinners.



TilGul Poli: A famous sweet roti prepared on Makar Sankranti. Whole wheat roti is stuffed with a mixture of sesame seeds, jiggery, roasted peanuts and ghee is poured over it. All these ingredients are prefect for winter.



Undhiyu: A unique vegetable relished by all Gujratis consists of many vegetables like eggplant, walpapdi, purple yam and methi muthias. It's cooked in an earthen pot buried in ground upside down.



Green Leafy Vegetables: Vegetables like Fenugreek, Spinach, Colocasia leaves are also good for winters.



Vegetable Soup: Nothing can beat a hot bowl of soup on cold evenings. Add as many vegetables as you can to make it healthy.



Ginger/Tulsi Tea: These teas not only keep you warm but also boost your immunity.



Gajar ka halwa: Winter foods cannot be completed without Gajar ka Halwa. Cooked in milk and enriched with khoya, ghee, dry fruits and cardamom, this is staple dessert for dinners.







### ESCAPE FROM AGRA



Shivaji Maharaj arrived in Agra with his eldest son Shambhuji and a few soldiers on 12th May, which was Aurangzeb's 50th birthday. As Shivaji Maharaj entered the hall and placed his gifts in front of Aurangzeb, the emperor said nothing to welcome him. In the court hall, Shivaji was placed behind the mansabdars (military commanders), and that's when he became sure that it was a trap. The plan was to send Maharaj to Kandahar (now in Afghanisthan). Shivaji maharaj realised this and stormed out of the court due to which he was placed under house arrest. Him and his son became captives and were imprisoned for many months. Maharaj was allocated in a spacious quarters in one of the big houses with

personal servants. He was always guarded by 1000 men, but this did not stop him. He became friends with the postmaster, a few subordinates and gathered information about whatever was happening around the kingdom.

One day Shivaji Maharaj pretended to be severely ill and requested Aurangzeb to let a few of his men go to the deccan, by doing this he ensured the safety of his army and deceived Aurangzeb. Aurangzeb granted his request, after which his men went and settled in several towns around, this was the beginning of his escape plan.



Shivaji Maharaj was allowed to send boxes of sweets and gifts to saints, fakirs and temples in Agra as offerings for his health. After a lot of waiting and exchanges, when he got to know how things work, he decided to execute his plan. On 17th August 1666, Shivaji maharaj and his son, sat in one of these gift boxes and escaped from Agra. After escaping they fled to Deccan where his men waited for them, there they disguised as Sadhus and went back home

This was how he not only escaped, but also managed to save his army and take them back with him.

# Terrace Gardening

rganic food is the new trend to follow and every other person is looking for everything organic may it be vegetables, cereals, grains or even cosmetics. And considering our changed lifestyle, this should

not just be a trend but something to carry on forever.

Earlier our houses used to have big backyards where our grandparents used to grow vegetables and fruits. Today we can't afford that luxury. Our lives are packed into compact apartments. What we get is small balcony or terrace outside to sit. But have you ever observed that everyone wants to add some greenery to that small space



called balcony? In our hectic lifestyle, these plants bring few moments of relaxation. Tending to these plants is actually a therapy to calm down your mind. Most of the times people have a Tulsi Vrindavan and a few flowering plants like jasmine or rose. But you can take it to next level and turn your balcony/ terrace into a small kitchen garden. There are such vegetables which can be grown easily in the pots. And this will also ensure that you get your own organic vegetables. We will slowly learn here how to make such





efore you start kitchen gardening, please consider following points:

- Find the right place Find a place where the sunlight is available for at least 4 to 6 hours for the plants.
- Medium to grow vegetables
- The best mixture comprises
- regular soil, compost and vermicompost. Cocopeat is also a good option.
- Containers You can use milk cartons, plastic containers,

as pots (or buy pots). Raised beds can be prepared if you have a large terrace but the flooring should be completely waterproof.

- Accessibility to water It should be easy for you to water and maintain your garden with ease.
- High-quality vegetable seeds It's crucial as it would ultimately decide the quality of the produce. You can find a variety of them on internet or can buy from any store.

### Single Stack Plumbing



THE PLUMBING SYSTEM OF A BUILDING INCLUDES THE WATER SUPPLY DISTRIBUTING PIPES; THE FIXTURE AND FIXTURE TRAPS; THE SOIL, WASTE AND VENT PIPES; THE BUILDING DRAIN AND BUILDING SEWER; THE STORM WATER DRAINAGE, WITH THEIR DEVICES AND CONNECTIONS.

he single stack, also commonly known as a wet vent system, is based on the theory that the drain lines will be of sufficient size to accommodate the three factors involved in any drainage system: solids, liquids and air. The single stack system was developed based on this theory.

In Single Stack Plumbing, single pipe is used to collect waste water from all sanitary as well as soil appliances. Its effectiveness depends on the depth of water seals.

The CBRI (Central Building Research Institute) Rookie has recommended the use of one pipe system in the modern multi-storeyed building due to its low cost. The single stack system

offers a compact layout. It avoids gully traps and is thus free from insect nuisance and obstruction etc.

At VJ, we are using single stack system for our YashONE Hinjawadi project. Here, Huliot pipes with Huliot Ultra Silent swept tees are being used.
