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विक्रीची वस्तू नव्हे, मायेची वास्तू!

चार भिंती आणि वर छप्पर म्हणजे घर नव्हे. गगनाला गवसणी घालु पाहणाऱ्या 'टॉवर्स'मधील आलिशान फ्लॅट म्हणजेही घर नव्हे किंवा छान टुमदार बंगली म्हणजेही घर नव्हे. छोटीशी झोपडी असो की टोलेजंग बंगला असो त्यांमध्ये माणसं राहायला आली आणि एकमेकांशी मायेनं वागू-बोलू लागली, तरच ती गजबजू लागतात; ती घर वाटू लागतात. अशा घरांमध्ये आई, बाबा, आजी, आजोबा, काका, काकू, मामा, मामी, आत्या, मावशी, मुलं, पुतणे, भाचे, नातवंड अशी अनेक नाती असतात. ती एका घरातच असतात असे नव्हे; परंतु ममत्वानं ती ही नाती जपत असतात; परस्परांच्या सुख-दु:खात सहभागी होत असतात, एकमेकांना आधार देत असतात. नातेसंबंध फुलविणारी आणि वृद्धिंगत करणारी, रोज काम संपल्यानंतर मायेच्या ओढीनं परत यायला लावणारी ही घरं म्हणजे आपल्या समाजव्यवस्थेचा आणि संस्कृतीचाही कणाच. म्हणून तर कुटुंबव्यवस्था टिकून आहे.

भारतीयांच्या घराबद्दलच्या भावना या अशा आहेत. 'वन रूम किंचन'मध्ये राहणारा असो किंवा मोठ्या बंगल्यातील असो प्रत्येकाची घराबद्दलची ओढ सारखीच असते. किंतीही मोठ्या आणि सुविधांयुक्त ऑफिसात असला, तरी प्रत्येकाला आपलं घरच खुणावत असतं मग ते छोटं असलं, माणसांची दाटी असली, तरी चालतं! आपलं स्वतःचं घर असावं, ही भावना तर प्रत्येक भारतीयाच्या मनात असते. शिक्षण संपवून कमवायला लागला, की बहुतेक तरुण-तरुणी स्वतःच्या घराची स्वप्नं पाहू लागतात. आपलं घर कसं असावं, ते कशा प्रकारे सजवावं, याच्या योजना तर घर घेण्याच्या आधीपासूनच तयार असतात.

घर घेणं किंवा बांधणं या गोष्टीला आपल्याकडं विलक्षण महत्त्व आहे. त्याकडे केवळ खरेदी-विक्री व्यवहार म्हणून पाहता येत नाही; त्याकडे सामाजिक, आर्थिक आणि सांस्कृतिक संदर्भाच्या चौकटीतून पाहावं लागेल. घर बांधण्याची तुलना तर लग्न करण्याशी केली जाते. म्हणूनच 'घर पाहावं बांधून अन् लग्न पाहावं करून' असं म्हटलं गेलं आहे.

पुण्यासारख्या विलक्षण वेगानं वाढणाऱ्या महानगरात 'घर पाहावं बांधून'ची प्रचिती घेणं सर्वसामान्यांना खरोखरीच अवघड बनल्यानं 'घर पाहावं विकत घेऊन' अशी दुरुस्ती त्यात करता येईल.

घर घेण ही सोपी गोष्ट नसली, तरी त्यासाठी कुटुंबातून, ऑफिसमधून आणि समाजातूनही प्रोत्साहन दिलं जातं. एखादी तरुण व्यक्ती स्वबळावर कमवू लागली, की तिला मिळणारा पहिला सल्ला असतो. तो घर घेण्याचं. या व्यक्तीच्या आई-वडलांचं घर असलं, तरी भविष्यातील तरतूद म्हणून, पुढं लग्न झाल्यावर म्हणून किंवा गुंतवणूक म्हणून घर घेण्याचा सल्ला दिला जातो आणि बहुतेक जण तो मानतात. पहिलं घर घेण्याचा अनुभव अतिशय विलक्षण असतो; आणि पहिल्या घरातील भावनिक गुंतवणूकही तुलनेनं अधिक असते! बहतेकांकडं घर घेण्याइतपत पैसे नसतात. आपल्याकडील शिल्लक, आई-वडील, इतर नातेवाइक, मित्रमंडळी यांकडून होऊ शकणारी मदत आणि आपल्या पगारावर मिळू शकणारं कर्ज अशी गणितं घातली जातात ती अनेकदा चुकतात. पुन्हा पुन्हा कागदावर हिशोब मांडला जातो. अखेर जुळवाजुळव होईल याची खात्री पटल्यानंतर घराचाशोध सुरू होतो. हव्या त्या भागात आपल्या बजेटमधलं घर मिळत नाही अन् बजेटमधलं घर मिळू शकणाऱ्या ठिकाणी आपल्याला जायचं नसतं. अशा वेळी कोणी तरी मदतीला येतो, कर्जाची रक्कम वाढविली जाते किंवा मधला मार्ग स्वीकारला जातो अन घर घेतलं जातं.

पुढं नोकरीत वा व्यवसायात स्थिरस्थावर झाल्यावर, मुलं मोठी होऊ लागल्यावर, त्यांना त्यांची 'स्पेस' देण्याची गरज भासू लागल्यावर मोठ्या घराची गरज भासू लागते. 'वन बीएचके'त असणाऱ्यांना 'टू बीएचके' हवं असतं, तर 'टू बीएचके'त राहणारे 'थ्री बीएचके' घर पाहू लागतात. 'थ्री बीएचके'तर राहणाऱ्यांना इप्लेक्स किंवा एखादा फार्म हाउस असावं, असं वाटू लागतं. पहिलं घर घेताना आर्थिक अडचण असल्याने खूप तडजोडी केलेल्या असतात. नवं घर घेताना मात्र ते ऐसपैस असावं, अधिक गॅलऱ्या असाव्यात, भरपूर पार्किंग असावं, खेळाचं मैदान असावं, जिम-स्वीमिंग पूल-जॉगिंग ट्रॅक-क्लब हाउस-रेन वॉटर हार्वेस्टिंग आदी सुविधा असाव्यात, आजूबाजूला सर्व सोयी असाव्यात असं वाटू लागतं. त्यासाठी थोडा अधिक आर्थिक ताण स्वीकारण्याची, नवरा-बायको दोघेही कमावणारे असल्यानं बजेट वाढविण्याची आणि प्रसंगी आतापर्यंतची बचत वा सोनंनाणं वापरण्याची तयारी असते.

अलीकडच्या काळात तर वृद्धापकाळाची तयारी म्हणून खास ज्येष्टसाठी असलेल्या घरांचाही विचार केला जात आहे. मुलं मोठी झाली आणि नोकरी-व्यवसायाच्या निमित्तानं परगावी वा परदेशी गेली तर त्यांच्यावाचून आपलं अडायला नको, कामवाल्या मावशींपासून किराणा आणून देणाऱ्यांपर्यंत आणि आजारपणात डॉक्टर उपलब्ध होण्यापासून वैद्यकीय सुविधा मिळण्यापर्यंत सर्व सोयी एकत्र असेल, अशा ठिकाणी घर घेणारेही वाढत आहेत. त्यामुळं गृहबांधणी व्यवसायाचं रूपांतर मोठ्या उद्योगात झालं आहे. उद्योग वाढला तरी त्यात केवळ रूक्ष व्यवहार करून चालणार नाही; कारण घर ही केवळ विक्रीची वस्तू नाही, तर एक मायेची वास्तू आहे! घर कसं असावं याच्या कल्पना आणि घर घेण्याच्या गरजा वयानुरूप बदलत असल्या तरी तिथली मायेची ऊब कायम आहे आणि कायम राहणार आहे!

The experience of buying a first home is unique; and the emotional investment in the first house is also relatively high! Most of them do not have enough money to buy a house. The calculations are complex. It involves own capital, capital that can be raised from parents/ friends, maximum possible loan on one's salary etc. Many a times these permutationscombinations also fail to match the expectations. Once convinced that there will be a match, the search for a house begins. But the struggle doesn't end here. Matching your budget with the prices in the locality of your choice is again one more hurdle difficult to cross. We see people around who find either a middle way, or those who are lucky ones find some helping hand and a dream is achieved.

One slowly gets settled in a job or business, children grow up and then the need for a bigger house arises out of need for 'personal space'. Everyone wants to upgrade from 1BHK to 2BHK to duplex or even a farm house. Unlike first house budget is no longer a constraint. And expectations are also heightened. HONESTY, TRANSPARENCY AND IMMENSE HARD WORK - THE SECRET OF VJ'S SUCCESS FOR 42 YEARS

Mr. Vilas Javdekar belonged to a middle class family where education was considered very important. Many people in and around the family were academician. One would wonder how come a person from such a humble background could build an empire like VJ? Interesting, Huh? Let's go on a time travel then.

Vilas's father was a Principal at Government College. Around 1962, his father, Mr. Yashwant Javdekar, was transferred to Amravati from Dhule. He then decided to make Pune a permanent dwelling place for his family, especially considering the educational facilities available there for his children.

His family of 6 lived very happily in a small space of just 280 sq. ft. in a Housing Board apartmentt. Ten years later, after his retirement, Mr. Yashwant Javdekar built a 6-room bungalow at Poud Phata of which they were using only three rooms. The other three were rented out.

Vilas was in 9th class when his family shifted to Pune and he further decided to pursue civil engineering staying in Pune itself. After becoming an Engineer he first joined the Town Planning Department of Government of Maharashtra. But somehow soon he started feeling that "This is not where my heart is". He left the job in five months and joined a private company as a Junior Engineer. He was appointed at Songad near Surat to look after

one paper mill being built there. But unfortunately this project came to a halt in just ten months and he had to return to Pune. He then joined one reputed contracting firm as site engineer and got posted in Aurangabad. He successfully completed the work of one Water Treatment Plant there in 3 years. Building a Water Treatment Plant was an uncommon thing then, and there were hardly 5-6 sites in entire Maharashtra. Hence, Vilas had to put a lot of efforts to understand everything that was required, right from designing to execution. He was aware that practicality is always different from theory. He worked with the labourers to learn centring, bar bending, plastering etc. This helped him understand what difficulties the labourers faced at the site. He could put this practical knowledge to use when he started his own business.

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We have grown almost 10 times in the last 10 years. And our greatest asset is our human capital whom we fondly call "VJ Pariyaar".

SARVESH JAVDEKAR
TECHNICAL DIRECTOR,
VILAS JAVDEKAR DEVELOPERS

After finishing the job at Aurangabad, he got posted at Shrirampur. The company he was working with earned another contract at Rahuri around the same time. Vilas was entrusted by the company to handle both the projects and he too not only looked after two projects single handed but also helped in some projects under progress at few other sites.



In the meantime, Vilas acquired expertise in hydraulic, functional and structural designs of water treatment plant.

Vilas got married in 1977. Kalpana, an intelligent woman from a middle-class family from Chitali village near Shirdi. became his companion. At that time he was earning some thousand rupees a month. But this was soon going to be insufficient due to his increasing family responsibilities. At that time, the owner of his company, who had seen Vilas working so hard, suggested him to start his own business. And he didn't just stop there but also introduced him to many people in the industry. This is how Vilas entered into business even when there was no such background in his family. Kalpana, his wife, then supported his decision and stood strong behind him. He started a company named 'V Y Javdekar Engineers & Contractors' and initially worked as a contractor. He received his first work order from the state government of value Rs.13,000/-. Vilas earned a profit of Rs.3000/- from this job.

In the beginning, he was getting petty jobs like building compound walls. A gentleman saw his work and asked if he would construct his 2-room house (with toilet block) for Rs.20,000/-. Vilas immediately took up this job. With the help of a carpenter and a mason Vilas completed this work in just two months. He made a profit of around Rs.4000/- from this job. Vilas realized that he was earning almost twice as that of his salary!



Vilas was handling everything about the business on his own. He was not dependent on anyone. He was confident about his work. Convinced with his hard work, Mr. Y. V. Deshpande, a highranking official at MIDC, gave him an opportunity to handle a big project and Vilas seized this opportunity. He saved a lot of money and ultimately MIDC was benefitted a lot. After this job, he started getting pretty big contracts. Vilas registered his company as 'Vilas Javdekar Contractors'. The company saw many ups and downs but it kept growing steadily. Vilas had very hardworking and honest people with him. Dhondiba, who worked with him for many years,



was a mason by profession but used to work like a Chief Engineer. Dhondiba and the other colleagues always delivered beyond expectations.

This journey wasn't all smooth. There were some rough patches too but Vilas was confident in himself and kept going. Around 1999, for the first time, his company got a contract worth Rs. 13 crores. So far the company was getting jobs up to the value of Rs. 5 crores. In a span of just 18 years, the company grew from earning the contracts worth Rs. Thirteen thousand to Thirteen crores.

Vilas once took up a contract to build Water Filtration Plant and finished it in mere two months which would have otherwise taken two years to complete. Gradually, he gained fame for taking up the difficult jobs that other contractors dared not do.



The business was growing and so were Vilas and Kalpana's two kids. Aditya and Sarvesh. Due to the nature of his work. Vilas used to be away from home many a times. But Kalpana didn't let kids feel his absence. Vilas also used to reserve Sundays to spend time with children. Kalpana brought them up well, instilled good values in them. She taught them to be honest, to nurture the bonds of brotherhood. She also pampered them a lot, especially when it came to food. Jaydekars was a religious family and the kids too imbibed that culture as they grew up. They could see the immense toil their father was putting in managing the business.



Our personal and professional lives are completely intertwined. My father and I, we both discuss the business in the morning. At times, my mother comes to me before going to bed to reveal the location of Temple in our new project. As a result, we are always working for our company. But I disagree with the term 'family-run-business'. At VJ, there are 1000 employees working for this business.

ADITYA JAVDEKAR CEO, VILAS JAVDEKAR DEVELOPERS



Vilas is very simple. He doesn't complain about anything. He is happy even if I just cook something different on his birthday! But he is also strict about certain things. When he says 'no' to something, it's forever.

I think accepting the situation is very important in life. If you accept it, you can overcome it in difficult times. This is what I have been doing till now and have always supported Vilas.

KALPANA JAVDEKAR

Mr. Vilas Javdekar's elder son, Aditya graduated to be a Mechanical Engineer while younger son Sarvesh became a Civil Engineer. Looking at the increasing scope of the business, both of them decided to join their father. When Aditya joined the company in 2000, the company was operating only in the field of infrastructural projects. The company was strong in engineering expertise; however the customer-facing team was not strong enough to cater to the residential projects. Aditya worked as a trainee on his first project. He learnt everything that goes into construction, from concreting to vibrator handling.

When the company entered the housing sector, Aditya took charge of the Marketing and the Business Development department while Aditya's younger brother Sarvesh, who joined the company later, took care of all technical know-how. The experiences of the previous generation coupled with the new ideas of the young generation made the company escalate to new heights of success.

Mr. Aditya Javdekar humbly accepts that in those early days he could not understand how to sell a house. He shares, "Selling a house was the most difficult thing for me. I later learnt that one doesn't have to focus on selling. One needs to earn the customers' trust in order to sell." According to him, building a house is a business for us builders and developers but buying a home is an emotional affair for the customers.

Today we witness at least one temple in every VJ project. One can easily trace the roots of this thought in the religious culture this Javdekar family comes from. Mrs. Kalpana Javdekar has willingly taken the responsibility of all these temples. 

The 3rd and final day of the festival commenced with a classical vocal performance of national award-winning artist Rahul Deshpande who is an Indian classical






